Project title	Lexical development in a comparative perspective: creating new language versions of Cross-Linguistic Lexical Tasks CLT	
Project description	The project will be part of the Multi-LADA Lab (MULTILINGUAL LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT AND ASSESSMENT LAB), directed by prof. Ewa Haman and will be carried out in cooperation with other teams participating in IDUB Action II 3.7. The project concerns the lexical development of multilingual children and effective methods for measuring their vocabulary. The method developed within the project is Cross-linguistic Lexical Tasks CLT. CLTs are part of the LITMUS battery (Language Impairment Testing in Multilingual Settings). As part of developing the method, collaborators creating the new language versions of the tasks receive support consisting in the form of software for conducting preparatory studies, assistance in analyzing their results and in selecting test items (based on the results of preparatory studies), as well as assistance in interpreting the results of pilot tests and developing final versions of CLT	

(http://psychologia.pl/clts/; Haman et al. 2015). CLT enable cross-cultural comparative research on lexical development related to universal and language-specific factors influencing this development (cf. Haman et al. 2017) and examining the specifics of lexical development in multilingual children developing typically and atypically (cf. Hansen et al., 2019; Simonsen and Haman, 2017). The project will be a continuation of research conducted since 2013, first as part of COST Action IS0804 (Bi-SLI), and now under the auspices of the LiTMUS Committee (of which Ewa Haman is a member). Within the project, knowledge of quantitative methods and advanced statistical analyses will be popularised among researchers and students of the University of Warsaw engaged in various types of language and language development research. 1. analysis of data obtained in research using CLT, reporting Job description and of research results, preparation of conference responsibilities presentations and scientific publications; 2. participation in the implementation of currently ongoing projects regarding the lexical development of mono- and multilingual children which use CLT; 3. developing international cooperation related to creating new CLT language versions: 4. developing international cooperation related to the transformation of CLT into diagnostic (psychometric) tools; 5. participation in submitting new grant applications related to lexical development in multilingual children using CLT; 6. co-design and maintenance of the CLT website and social media profiles related to CLT; 7. co-design and testing of applications for tablets and computers, to be prepared for testing children using CLT; 8. handling of licenses for the CLT picture database granted to foreign scientific institutions by the University of Warsaw; 9. contacting the faculty administration (e.g. Chief Accountant/Quaestor's Representative), university offices (e.g. Research Service Office) in matters related to licensing the CLT image database; 10.strengthening inter-unit cooperation at the University of Warsaw in the field of interdisciplinary language research, initiating new activities, disseminating statistical knowledge, experimental and quantitative methods among language researchers at the University of Warsaw. Key requirements We will consider candidates who fulfil the following requirements. They: 1. meet the conditions set out in the Act on Higher Education and Science of 20 July 2018 (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 85 as amended) and the Statute of the University of

	 Warsaw (Resolution No. 443 of the University of Warsaw Senate of 26 June 2019, Monitor item 190), have a PhD in social sciences in the field of psychology or a PhD in the humanities in the field of linguistics or related discipline, have scientific achievements documented in publications in renowned international journals (the candidate should be the first author of at least two published papers in a journal from the JCR list), have experience in research in the field of language development of multilingual children and in the designing of assessment tools measuring the level of language development of monolingual and/or multilingual children, take an active part in scientific conferences, know data analysis software, are fluent in English, spoken and written. Additionally, the following assets are welcome: experience in organizational work in a scientific environment (e.g. management of a research project, experience as a secretary or manager of a research project), experience in studies of monolingual and multilingual children regarding lexical development using CLT, confirmed by publications, experience in the dissemination of quantitative statistical methods used in research on language development among practitioners involved in assessing the language functioning of children or adults.

Purpose and legal grounds of data processing

Data retention period

Data recipients

Officers authorized by the Controller shall have access to your personal data, the processing of which is in the scope of their duties.

Data transfer outside the European Economic Area (EEA)

Your personal data shall be disclosed to subjects authorized by law. Signing-in is through Google Forms. Your personal data may be also processed by our provider of G-Suit for education by Google Company in their data processing centres.⁸ Your data shall be protected under the standards of the Privacy Shield, accepted by the European Commission.⁹ This shall guarantee an adequate level of data security.
